STATEMENT REGARDING THE RE-ELECTION OF PRESIDENT DONALD J. TRUMP

AND ELECTION RESULTS IN SPOKANE COUNTY

Yesterday, Election Day November 5, 2024, We the People of America spoke loudly about the direction we want this Country to go by electing Donald J. Trump as the 47th President of this great Country. Happily, the majority of Spokane County voters agreed with the rest of America. Sadly, Washington State as a whole did not.

Separately, Spokane County voters, in conjunction with the voters from the other 11 counties in the 5th Congressional District, elected Michael Baumgartner as the future US Representative from this Congressional District with nearly 60% of the total votes cast.

As well, Spokane County voters voted in the majority for the Republican candidate for each of the statewide Executive positions, including Dave Reichert for Governor, and Dale Whitaker for Secretary of State and Matt Hawkins for State Auditor (both of Spokane County). Sadly, the west side of Washington State did not follow our lead, and so none of the Statewide Executive positions will be filled with a Republican. Spokane County voters spoke with their voice in electing or re-electing the three Republican candidates in the 4th Legislative District, the two Republican candidates in the 6th Legislative District, the two Republican candidates in the 7th Legislative District and finally, the three Republican candidates in the 9th Legislative District.

Spokane County voters voted in the majority for both Republican Candidates for the 3rd and 5th County Commissioner Districts, Josh Kerns and Al French. National Sovereignty, Immigration and Defense



Bingle at the Border

In March 2024, Spokane City Councilman Jonathan Bingle traveled to Arizona to see the border. Excerpts from an article published March 11, 2024 at The Center Square.

"The people I met with in Nogales want us to understand this isn't an Arizona or a Texas problem, this is a U.S. problem," said Bingle. "They told me you don't think you're a border town, but because of this crisis every town is a border town."

Q: What does the border actually look like?

Bingle: More intense than you think. On the other side of the border the poverty is right there. The wall is far larger and longer than you can imagine, more aggressive than you can imagine. Razor wire over the top and the middle and it's seriously tall, 15'-20' tall. It's big and it's effective. Where there's no wall is cartel territory.

Q: What were your big take aways from the trip?

Bingle: In almost every conceivable way it's worse than you think. Border Patrol morale, it's worse than you think. Coyotes exploiting women and children, it's worse than you think. Best estimates I heard were 7 to 10 million people have crossed illegally since Biden became president. That's as many as 200,000 people per state, a new city the size of Spokane in all 50 states. Even on the low end, 7 million is larger than 34 states total population, all added in last three years.

Most people say they are looking for work and opportunity and they are, but let's say just a half of one percent of 10 million are serious criminals, that's 50,0000 nasty, violent people who came into the country during the Biden administration. That's still a thousand per state and that's crazy.

Q: Was Spokane mentioned as a destination?

Bingle: Spokane County is one of the federally designated High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas so I absolutely believe Spokane is one of those places they tell them to come. They believe the opportunity here is so great it was worth their life to try to get in. It reminds us what a great country we have and how much we take it for granted.

I'm certain that our State Republican Party and the County GOP will be strategizing on how to get more people to exercise their right to vote and will be educating them on what Republican candidates bring to the table. Initiatives in WA State are also a great concern as only 1 of the 4 on the ballot passed. There was lots of propaganda from those who opposed common sense and, unfortunately, it's going to impact every person living in our state because tax on gasoline and other climate control measures could cost everyone more money than ever!

Our Spokane County Clerk, Tim Fitzgerald, our featured speaker this month, shared some amazing facts about the Spokane Regional Veterans Court and the Spokane Veterans Forum. Established in 2010, "the Spokane Veterans Forum (SVF) program plays a crucial role in preparing these veterans for reintegration into society, enabling them to reclaim their roles as productive citizens while saving the community the substantial costs of incarceration. Remarkably, 65 veteran defendants have reported that, without the intervention of the Spokane Veterans Forum, they would have contemplated suicide, " https://spokaneveteransforum.org/. This two-year program in Spokane has nationally recognize success with 519 graduates (as of October 2023). There are over 237 Veterans Courts nationwide. The rate of recidivism nationally is 73%, while the program in Spokane has a rate of only 5.8%.

At the luncheon PRW also accepted donations for our "Caring for America" projects, The proceeds this time will be divided between two local veteran organizations.

We look forward to having our last meeting of 2024 on December 17th at the Ruby River Hotel at 11:45 a.m. RSVPs for lunch can be made through our

website: <u>ponderosarepublicanwomen.com</u>. Our guest speakers will be from Teen Challenge; a graduate of their program will share their own personal story.
