WALSH: "The main measure of success here is simple: At the precinct caucuses, get good people elected as delegates to the county conventions. But there are other goals, too. Attract new people to WAGOP. Give them a forum. Encourage new and existing activists about WAGOP policies and candidates. Energize them to stay engaged through November. And beyond."

At the County Conventions, delegates will be elected to the WAGOP State Convention to be held in Spokane April 18-20. As Jim Walsh said: "This will be a State Convention unlike any other in years. The delegates (2,500 are planned) will nominate and endorse Republican candidates for the nine statewide executive positions (Governor, LT. Governor, Secretary of State, Attorney General, State Treasurer, State Auditor, Commissioner of Public Lands, Superintendent of Public Instruction, and Insurance Commissioner), the 10 U.S. Congress positions and the one U.S. Senate position on the ballot in 2024." All State positions, 7 of the 10 Congressional seats and the one Senator up for re-election are Democrats. It is important that we all get involved and nominate excellent candidates that support our GOP principles; candidates that will have our support and can raise the funds to get elected.

"We are vulnerable to hypocrisy because we value our freedom to act in our own self-interest. We don't naturally grant the same consideration to others, sometimes seeking to use government as a tool to impose our interests on others. The Bill of Rights was specifically designed to limit government's ability to be used this way. The most common arguments over the 1st and 2nd Amendments are a great illustration of our vulnerability to hypocrisy.

From a strictly Constitutional originalist world view, there is no basis in the Bill of Rights for any interference with the 2nd Amendment Right to Bear Arms. However, most 2nd Amendment defenders (including the NRA) agree it's in our collective self-interest to allow limited restrictions. Emphasis on limited.

Conservatives turn around and object to values-free violence and bias in the media. Some of the most vocal defenders of freedom of expression are from the movie industry. When Hollywood defends the 1st Amendment and attacks the 2nd, you can smell the hypocrisy in the air as acrid as gun smoke in the aftermath of a movie blockbuster bloodbath.

Journalists would rightly howl at the idea of mental health and criminal background checks for licensing a newspaper or website. Yet even movie makers and newspaper editors accept limited restrictions. Emphasis on limited.

We are always eager to point out the speck in another's eye without first removing the log from our own, but an opinion column is in the speck identification business. Criticizing government transportation spending doesn't mean giving up driving on public roads. Following the current overly complicated tax code, loopholes and all, doesn't stand in the way of advocating for a simpler loophole-free tax system. Benefiting from a government program one didn't ask for does not remove a citizen's right to criticize the program. Advocating for smaller government doesn't mean abolishing government."
