Jim grew up in Tacoma and went to WSU, playing basketball for the Cougar freshman team in 1971-72. After graduation, he worked for Seattle First National Bank and attended night school at Seattle Pacific University and the University of Washington, but followed a path to entrepreneurship, starting in the Tri-Cities in 1977. There he met his wife of 39 years, Kathleen.

They moved to Spokane where Jim took up a career in real estate, also serving as chairman of the Steering Committee and on the Government Affairs Committee for the Spokane Association of Realtors. Over 36 years he managed offices for several major firms, eventually staring his own enterprise in 2013.

Jim served five years on the City of Spokane Plan Commission, served on the local board for the L'Arche community, part of an international organization dedicated to serving developmentally disabled adults, and was co-founder of Charlie Mike Veterans Pathways, serving the veterans community. Jim coached youth sports, starting as a baseball

coach in the Hilltop area of Tacoma in 1972 through 2016 in Spokane, mostly in basketball and football.

Jim has given talks on Mental Conditioning to high school sports teams in the Spokane area and California and is in the process of writing his first book. He also finished his first half-marathon in May.

In addition, Jim plays an active role in his church and had an audience with the Pope in Rome in 2014.

His three adult children attended Gonzaga Prep, two sons graduating from WSU and daughter Aly from the University of Idaho. One of his sons is an Army veteran, serving in the Middle East and Ukraine while his oldest son currently serves in the Air Force. Jim currently has two grand children with a two more on the way.
